BYLAW NO. 2-94

A BYLAW RESPECTING THE SITUATING OF BUILDINGS

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Douglas No. 436 in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. In this bylaw:

"road" means any road allowance within the Rural Municipality of Douglas No. 436 other than:

- (i) a private road;
- (ii) a provincial highway;
- (iii) a road or streets within a hamlet.
- No building shall be situated a distance of less than sixty (60) meters from the centre line of any road.
- 3. No building shall be situated a distance of less than ninety (90) metres from an intersection of roads.
- 4. This bylaw does not apply with respect to buildings situated prior to the passing of the bylaw.
- 5. Every person who causes a building to be situated in contravention of this bylaw shall be guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction to the penalties imposed in the General Penalty Bylaw of the Rural Municipality of Douglas No. 436.
